## A BILL

To extend temporarily the suspension of duty on mixtures or coprecipitates of lanthanum phosphate, cerium-doped lanthanum phosphate, cerium phosphate, and terbium phosphate.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. MIXTURES OR COPRECIPITATES OF LAN-**  
4                       **THANUM PHOSPHATE, CERIUM-DOPED LAN-**  
5                       **THANUM PHOSPHATE, CERIUM PHOSPHATE,**  
6                       **AND TERBIUM PHOSPHATE.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.05 of the Har-  
8       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to

1 mixtures or coprecipitates of lanthanum phosphate, ce-  
2 rium-doped lanthanum phosphate, cerium phosphate, and  
3 terbium phosphate) is amended by striking the date in the  
4 effective column period and inserting “12/31/2011”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
6 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
7 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
8 the date of the enactment of this Act.
