- 3 SECTION 1. MIXTURES OR COPRECIPITATES OF LAN-
- 4 THANUM PHOSPHATE, CERIUM-DOPED LAN-
- 5 THANUM PHOSPHATE, CERIUM PHOSPHATE,
- 6 AND TERBIUM PHOSPHATE.
- 7 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.23.05 of the Har-
- 8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to

- 1 mixtures or coprecipitates of lanthanum phosphate, ce-
- 2 rium-doped lanthanum phosphate, cerium phosphate, and
- 3 terbium phosphate) is amended by striking the date in the
- 4 effective column period and inserting "12/31/2011".
- 5 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 6 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 7 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 8 the date of the enactment of this Act.
