To suspend temporarily the duty on artificial flowers of man-made fibers assembled as a single species bush, with or without foliage.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS OF MAN-MADE FIBERS**

4 **ASSEMBLED AS A SINGLE SPECIES BUSH,**

5 **WITH OR WITHOUT FOLIAGE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Artificial flowers of man-made fibers assembled as a single species bush, with or without foliage (provided for in subheading 6702.90.35) ...	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
