## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on threaded stoppers, caps, and lids of base metal with chromium or gold-plated finish, of a type and size suitable for use on salt-and-pepper shakers, perfume bottles, and the like.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. THREADED STOPPERS, CAPS, AND LIDS OF**  
 2 **BASE METAL WITH CHROMIUM OR GOLD-**  
 3 **PLATED FINISH, OF A TYPE AND SIZE SUIT-**  
 4 **ABLE FOR USE ON SALT-AND-PEPPER SHAK-**  
 5 **ERS, PERFUME BOTTLES, AND THE LIKE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
 7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
 8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
 9 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Threaded stoppers, caps, and lids of base metal with chromium or gold-plated finish, of a type and size suitable for use on salt-and-pepper shakers, perfume bottles, and the like (provided for in subheading 8309.90.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
 11 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
 12 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
 13 the date of the enactment of this Act.
