A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on digital camera lenses.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIGHTWEIGHT DIGITAL CAMERA LENSES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Lenses designed for digital cameras, the foregoing with a focal length measuring approximately 10 mm or more but not over 24 mm and weighing between 455 and 465 grams (provided for in subheading 9002.11.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
