1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3 SECTION 1. CALCIUM CHLORIDE PHOSPHATE PHOSPHOR.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.22.70 of the Har5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 calcium chloride phosphate phosphor) is amended by strik7 ing the date in the effective period column and inserting
8 "12/31/2011".

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- $2 \ \ {\rm the \ date \ of \ the \ enactment \ of \ this \ Act.}$
