A BILL

To extend temporarily the suspension of duty on strontium magnesium phosphate-tin doped inorganic products.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STRONTIUM MAGNESIUM PHOSPHATE-TIN**
4 **DOPED INORGANIC PRODUCTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.22.68 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 strontium magnesium phosphate-tin doped inorganic prod-
8 ucts) is amended by striking the date in the effective pe-
9 riod column and inserting “12/31/2011”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
