1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN WINDOW SHADE MATERIAL IN ROLLS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

"	9902.01.00	Window shade material in rolls measuring between 300 and 500 square feet com- posed of wood slats between 6 mm and 8 mm wide or 22 mm and 25 mm wide and 1 mm and 2 mm thick, and/or bamboo reeds between 1 mm and 2.5 mm wide, and/or marupa wood rods between 1.5 mm and 3 mm in diame- ter, and/or paper rope, woven with polyester yarn into a re- peating pattern which may also include jute, yarn, and/or paper materials (provided for in subheading 4601.94.20)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 the date of the enactment of this Act.
