1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MARTIN G. “MARTY” MAHAR POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 2–116th Street in North Troy,

1 New York, shall be known and designated as the “Martin
2 G. ‘Marty’ Mahar Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Martin G. ‘Marty’
7 Mahar Post Office”.
