1 **SECTION 1. SERGEANT CHRISTOPHER R. HRBEK POST OF-**
2 **FICE BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 216 Westwood Avenue in
5 Westwood, New Jersey, shall be known and designated as
6 the “Sergeant Christopher R. Hrbek Post Office Build-
7 ing”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
10 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
11 be deemed to be a reference to the “Sergeant Christopher
12 R. Hrbek Post Office Building”.
