6 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub7 paragraph:

"(G) The following activities carried out at the 8 9 offices of Members of Congress for such Members: "(i) The distribution of information to 10 11 members of the Armed Forces, veterans, and 12 their dependents about the benefits and services under laws administered by the Secretary and 13 other appropriate governmental and non-gov-14 ernmental programs. 15

"(ii) The preparation and processing of papers and other documents, including documents
to assist in the preparation and presentation of
claims for benefits under laws administered by
the Secretary.".
