Mr. BUNNING introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred  
to the Committee on Finance

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## A BILL

To allow individuals to elect to opt out of the Medicare  
part A benefits.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ALLOWING INDIVIDUALS TO ELECT TO OPT**  
4       **OUT OF THE MEDICARE PART A BENEFIT.**

5       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in the  
6       case of an individual who elects to opt out of benefits  
7       under part A of title XVIII of the Social Security Act,  
8       such individual shall not be required to—

9               (1) opt out of benefits under title II of such Act  
10       as a condition for making such election; and

- 1           (2) repay any amount paid under such part A
- 2       for items and services furnished prior to making
- 3       such election.
