## A BILL

To allow individuals to elect to opt out of the Medicare part A benefits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. ALLOWING INDIVIDUALS TO ELECT TO OPT

OUT OF THE MEDICARE PART A BENEFIT.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in the case of an individual who elects to opt out of benefits under part A of title XVIII of the Social Security Act, such individual shall not be required to—

(1) opt out of benefits under title II of such Act

as a condition for making such election; and

1	(2) repay any amount paid under such part A
2	for items and services furnished prior to making
3	such election.
