## A BILL

To help certain communities adversely affected by FEMA's flood mapping modernization program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FLOOD MAP MODERNIZATION AND FLOOD PRO-
- 4 TECTION SYSTEMS.
- 5 (a) Suspension of Mapping Updates.—Notwith-
- 6 standing subsections (e) and (f) of section 1360 of the
- 7 National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4101(e)
- 8 and (f)), the Administrator of the Federal Emergency
- 9 Management Agency shall not revise, update, or publish
- 10 any flood insurance rate map under its Flood Map Mod-

- 1 ernization Program (commonly referred to as "Map
- 2 Mod") for any counties that are protected by a structure
- 3 built or maintained by the Army Corps of Engineers un-
- 4 less the affected owner of such structure or the community
- 5 protected by such structure—
- 6 (1) has been formally notified of any defi-7 ciencies in such structure; and
- 8 (2) has been afforded 7 years to rectify any 9 such deficiencies that would affect the flood insur-10 ance rate map for the geographic area in which such 11 structure or community is located.
- 12 (b) Limitation on Required Purchase; Suspen-
- 13 SION OF PREMIUM INCREASES.—Until such time as the
- 14 owner of a structure described in subsection (a) has been
- 15 afforded 7 years to rectify any identified deficiencies in
- 16 the structure, and notwithstanding the mandatory pur-
- 17 chase requirements of sections 102 and 202 of the Flood
- 18 Disaster Protection Act of 1973 (42 U.S.C. 4012a, 4106),
- 19 the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management
- 20 Agency shall not—
- 21 (1) require owners of property located in any
- county described in subsection (a) who, prior to the
- date of enactment of this Act were not required to
- 24 purchase flood insurance, to purchase flood insur-
- ance; and

1 (2) for owners of property located in any county 2 described in subsection (a) that had purchased flood 3 insurance prior to the date of enactment of this Act, 4 increase the risk premium rate charged for such 5 flood insurance.
