7	(a) Repeal of Limitation.—Section 3695 of title
8	38, United States Code, is amended—
9	(1) in subsection (a), by striking "The aggre-
10	gate" and inserting "Except as otherwise provided
11	in this section, the aggregate"; and
12	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
13	section:
14	"(c) In the case of an individual who served on active
15	duty in the Armed Forces for not less than four years,
16	the limitation in subsection (a) shall not apply with respect
17	to the receipt by such individual of assistance under chap-
18	ter 30 or 33 of this title, on the one hand, and the receipt
19	by such individual of assistance under chapter 1606 or
20	1607 of title 10, on the other hand.".
21	(b) Retroactive Application.—Subsection (c) of
22	such section, as added by subsection (a) of this section,
23	shall apply with respect to any individual described in such
24	subsection (c) regardless of whether the individual's re-
25	ceipt of assistance under chapter 1606 or 1607 of title

- 2 of the enactment of this Act.
