To amend the Fish and Wildlife Improvement Act of 1978 to exempt subsistence users in the State of Alaska from the prohibition on taking.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FOR SUBSISTENCE USERS.
- 4 Section 3(h)(2) of the Fish and Wildlife Improvement
- 5 Act of 1978 (16 U.S.C. 712(1)) is amended by adding
- 6 at the end: "A taking authorized under this section shall
- 7 be exempt from the prohibition on taking under section

- 1 1 of the Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp
- 2 Act (16 U.S.C. 718a)."
