A BILL

To amend the Federal Meat Inspection Act to revise the definition of the term “adulterated” to include contamination with *E. coli*.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF ADULTERATED.**

4 Section 1(m) of the Federal Meat Inspection Act (21
5 U.S.C. 601(m)) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (8), by striking “or” at the
7 end;

8 (2) in paragraph (9), by striking the period at
9 the end and inserting “; or”; and

10 (3) by adding at the end the following:

1 “(10) if it is contaminated with
2 enterohemorrhagic (EHEC) Shiga toxin-producing
3 serotypes of *Escherichia coli* (*E. coli*).”.
