## A BILL

To require small business training for contracting officers.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Small Business Train-
- 5 ing in Federal Contracting Certification Act of 2010".
- 6 SEC. 2. SMALL BUSINESS TRAINING.
- 7 Section 37(f)(3) of the Office of Federal Procurement
- 8 Policy Act (41 U.S.C. 433(f)) is amended—
- 9 (1) by striking "For each career path," and in-
- serting the following:

1	"(A) In General.—For each career
2	path,"; and
3	(2) by adding at the end the following:
4	"(B) CERTIFICATION PROGRAM.—
5	"(i) In general.—The Administrator
6	shall establish a certification program for
7	acquisition personnel. The certification
8	program shall be carried out through the
9	Federal Acquisition Institute.
10	"(ii) Small business training.—
11	The certification program under this sub-
12	paragraph shall include training regard-
13	ing—
14	"(I) small business government
15	contracting set-aside programs, in-
16	cluding—
17	"(aa) programs for
18	HUBZone small business con-
19	cerns, small business concerns
20	owned and controlled by service-
21	disabled veterans, and small busi-

12	Business Technology Transfer

17	"(II) determining small business
18	size standards and using North Amer-
19	ican Industry Classification System
20	codes in relation to contracting set-
21	aside programs and subcontracting
22	goals; and
23	"(III) any other issue relating to
24	contracting with small business con-
25	cerns (as defined under section 3 of
