# A BILL

To ensure that the right of an individual to display the Service Flag on residential property not be abridged.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Blue Star/Gold Star
- 5 Flag Act of 2010".

#### 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

7 In this Act:

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(1) The term "Service Flag" means a service

2	flag for purposes section 901 of title 36, United
3	States Code.
4	(2) The terms "condominium association" and
5	"cooperative association" have the meanings given
6	such terms under section 604 of Public Law 96–399
7	(15 U.S.C. 3603).
8	(3) The term "residential real estate manage-
9	ment association" has the meaning given such term
10	under section 528 of the Internal Revenue Code of
11	1986 (26 U.S.C. 528).
12	(4) The term "member"—
13	(A) as used with respect to a condominium
14	association, means an owner of a condominium
15	unit (as defined under section 604 of Public
16	Law 96–399 (15 U.S.C. 3603)) within such as-
17	sociation;
18	(B) as used with respect to a cooperative
19	association, means a cooperative unit owner (as
20	defined under section 604 of Public Law 96–
21	399 (15 U.S.C. 3603)) within such association;
22	and
23	(C) as used with respect to a residential
24	real estate management association, means an
25	owner of a residential property within a subdivi-

sion, development, or similar area subject to
 any policy or restriction adopted by such asso ciation.

### 4 SEC. 3. RIGHT TO DISPLAY THE SERVICE FLAG.

5 A condominium association, cooperative association, 6 or residential real estate management association may not 7 adopt or enforce any policy, or enter into any agreement, 8 that would restrict or prevent a member of the association 9 from displaying the Service Flag on residential property 10 within the association with respect to which such member has a separate ownership interest or a right to exclusive 11 12 possession or use.

### 13 SEC. 4. LIMITATIONS.

14 Nothing in this Act shall be considered to permit any15 display or use that is inconsistent with—

16 (1) any regulations prescribed by the Secretary
17 of Defense regarding rules or customs pertaining to
18 the proper display or use of the Service Flag; or

(2) any reasonable restriction pertaining to the
time, place, or manner of displaying the Service Flag
necessary to protect a substantial interest of the
condominium association, cooperative association, or
residential real estate management association.

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
