## A BILL

To protect American job creation by striking the job-killing Federal employer mandate.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "American Job Protec-
- 5 tion Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROTECT JOB CREATION.
- 7 Sections 1513 and 1514 and subsections (e), (f), and
- 8 (g) of section 10106 of the Patient Protection and Afford-
- 9 able Care Act (and the amendments made by such sections
- 10 and subsections) are repealed and the Internal Revenue

- 1 Code of 1986 shall be applied and administered as if such
- 2 provisions and amendments had never been enacted.
