1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR PERFORM-**  
2 **ANCE OF MEDICAL DISABILITY EXAMINA-**  
3 **TIONS BY CONTRACT PHYSICIANS.**

4       Section 704(c) of the Veterans Benefits Act of 2003  
5 (Public Law 108–183; 38 U.S.C. 5101 note) is amended  
6 by striking “December 31, 2010” and inserting “Decem-  
7 ber 31, 2012”.
