1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. RESTRICTIONS RELATING TO FOREIGN ENTI-4 TIES. (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 207(f) of title 18, United 5 States Code, is amended— 6 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking "1 year" and 7 inserting "5 years"; and 8 (2) by striking paragraph (3) and inserting the 9

1	"(3) Definition.—In this subsection, the term
2	'foreign entity' means—
3	"(A) the government of a foreign country,
4	as defined in section 1(e) of the Foreign Agents
5	Registration Act of 1938 (22 U.S.C. 611(e));
6	"(B) a foreign political party, as defined in
7	section 1(f) of the Foreign Agents Registration
8	Act of 1938 (22 U.S.C. 611(f)); and
