A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to publish in the Federal Register a list of States that have not submitted certain information required under chapter 69 of title 31, United States Code.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Payment in Lieu of
5 Taxes Amendments Act of 2010”.

6 **SEC. 2. PAYMENT IN LIEU OF TAXES.**

7 Section 6903 of title 31, United States Code, is
8 amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “(e) CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION.—The Sec-
2 retary of the Interior shall submit to the Committee on
3 Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate and the
4 Committee on Natural Resources of the House of Rep-
5 resentatives a list of States that have not submitted to
6 the Secretary the data required to calculate payments
7 under this title by January 15 of each year.

8 “(f) PUBLICATION.—The Secretary of the Interior
9 shall—

10 “(1) publish in the Federal Register and on the
11 Department of the Interior website a list of States
12 that have not submitted to the Secretary the data
13 required to calculate payments under this title by
14 February 1 of each year; and

15 “(2) update the list published on the Depart-
16 ment of the Interior website under paragraph (1) to
17 reflect any changes in the list.

18 “(g) ISSUANCE OF PAYMENTS.—Not later than May
19 1 of each fiscal year, the Secretary of the Interior shall
20 issue the payments authorized under this chapter.”.
