To amend title 18, United States Code, to include constrictor snakes of the species Python genera as an injurious animal.

1 **SECTION 1. IMPORTATION OR SHIPMENT OF INJURIOUS**  
 2 **SPECIES.**

3 Section 42(a)(1) of title 18, United States Code, is  
 4 amended in the first sentence by inserting “; of the con-  
 5 strictor snake of the species *Python genera*” after  
 6 “polymorpha”.

7 **SECTION 1. IMPORTATION OR SHIPMENT OF INJURIOUS**  
 8 **SPECIES.**

9 Section 42(a)(1) of title 18, United States Code, is  
 10 amended in the first sentence by inserting “; of any existing  
 11 or subsequently discovered member of the species *Python*  
 12 *molurus* (including *Python bivittatus* (also known as  
 13 ‘*Python molurus bivittatus*’)), *Broghammerus reticulatus*  
 14 (also known as ‘*Python reticulatus*’), *Python sebae*, *Python*  
 15 *natalensis* (also known as ‘*Python sebae natalensis*’), *Boa*  
 16 *constrictor*, *Eunectes notaeus*, *Eunectes deschauenseei*,  
 17 *Eunectes murinus*, or *Eunectes beniensis*” after  
 18 “polymorpha”.
