- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF PREFERENTIAL TREATMENT FOR
- 4 CERTAIN TEXTILE ARTICLES.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any provision of
- 6 title V of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2461 et seq.;
- 7 relating to the Generalized System of Preferences), no tex-
- 8 tile article classifiable under subheading 9404.30.80 of the
- 9 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is eligi-

- 1 ble for duty-free or other preferential treatment under
- 2 such title V.
- 3 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) applies to goods
- 4 entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption,
- 5 on or after the 15th day after the date of the enactment
- 6 of this Act.
