1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3 SECTION 1. APPLICABILITY TO VETERANS OF OPERATION

4 NEW DAWN OF PROVISIONS OF FEDERAL LAW
5 RELATING TO VETERANS OF OPERATION
6 IRAQI FREEDOM.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Unless otherwise terminated by8 an explicit delimiting or other termination date, any ref-

erence to Operation Iraqi Freedom in a provision of Fed eral law providing a benefit for service in the Armed
 Forces shall be deemed to include a reference to Operation
 New Dawn.

5 (b) COMBAT OPERATIONS.—For purposes of title 38, 6 United States Code, the service of a veteran while on ac-7 tive duty in the active military, naval, or air service in 8 Operation New Dawn shall be considered service while on 9 active duty in the active military, naval, or air service in 10 combat against a hostile force during a period of hostilities 11 (as defined in section 1712A(a)(2)(B) of such title).
