2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RICHARD LEWIS THORNBURGH COURTHOUSE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The United States courthouse,
5 located at 700 Grant Street in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania,
6 shall be known and designated as the “Richard Lewis
7 Thornburgh Courthouse”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the United States courthouse referred to in sub-
4 section (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Rich-
5 ard Lewis Thornburgh Courthouse”.
