12 "(e) DEFINITION OF DEPENDENT.—In this section,
13 the term 'dependent' has the meaning given that term in
14 section 1072 of this title.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting
after the item relating to section 2651 the following new
item:

"2652. Space-available travel on department of defense aircraft: reserve members, reserve members eligible for retired pay but for age; widows and widowers of retired members and dependents.".

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
