Mr. BEGICH introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to permit the use of commissary and exchange facilities by former members of the Armed Forces who were retired or separated for physical disability.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. USE OF COMMISSARY AND EXCHANGE FACILI-**
 2 **TIES BY FORMER MEMBERS OF THE ARMED**
 3 **FORCES WHO WERE RETIRED OR SEPARATED**
 4 **FOR PHYSICAL DISABILITY.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 54 of title 10, United
 6 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1063
 7 the following new section:

8 **“§ 1063a. Use of commissary stores and MWR retail**
 9 **facilities: former members retired or sep-**
 10 **arated for physical disability**

11 “(a) ELIGIBILITY OF FORMER MEMBERS.—A former
 12 member of the armed forces who was retired or separated
 13 from the armed forces for physical disability under chapter
 14 61 of this title shall be permitted to use commissary stores
 15 and MWR retail facilities on the same basis as members
 16 of the armed forces on active duty.

17 “(b) MWR RETAIL FACILITY DEFINED.—In this sec-
 18 tion, the term ‘MWR retail facility’ has the meaning given
 19 that term in section 1063(e) of this title.”.

20 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
 21 at the beginning of chapter 54 of such title is amended
 22 by inserting after the item relating to section 1063 the
 23 following new item:

“1063a. Use of commissary stores and MWR retail facilities: former members
 retired or separated for physical disability.”.
