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## A BILL

To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to prevent the approval of genetically-engineered fish.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PREVENTING THE APPROVAL OF GENETI-**  
4       **CALLY-ENGINEERED FISH.**

5       Section 512(a) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cos-  
6       metic Act (21 U.S.C. 360b(a)) is amended by adding at  
7       the end the following new paragraph:

8               “(7) Notwithstanding any other provision of  
9       this section, a genetically-engineered fish shall be

1 deemed unsafe under this section, including for pur-  
2 poses of section 402(a)(2)(C)(ii).”.

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
