# **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Morris K. Udall Schol-
- 5 arship and Excellence in National Environmental Policy
- 6 Amendments Act of 2009".

# 1 SEC. 2. SHORT TITLE.

2 Section 1 of the Morris K. Udall Scholarship and Ex3 cellence in National Environmental and Native American
4 Public Policy Act of 1992 (20 U.S.C. 5601 note; Public
5 Law 102–259) is amended to read as follows:

#### 6 "SEC. 1. SHORT TITLE.

7 "This Act may be cited as the 'Morris K. Udall and8 Stewart L. Udall Foundation Act'.".

# 9 SEC. 3. FINDINGS.

Section 3 of the Morris K. Udall and Stewart L.
Udall Foundation Act (20 U.S.C. 5601) is amended—

- 12 (1) in paragraph (3), by striking "and" at the13 end;
- 14 (2) in paragraph (4), by striking the period at15 the end and inserting a semicolon; and
- 16 (3) by adding at the end the following:
- 17 "(5) the Foundation—

"(A) since 1995, has operated exceptional
scholarship, internship, and fellowship programs
for areas of study related to the environment
and Native American tribal policy and health
care;

23 "(B) since 1999, has provided valuable en24 vironmental conflict resolution services and
25 leadership through the United States Institute
26 for Environmental Conflict Resolution; and

1	"(C) is committed to continue making a
2	substantial contribution toward public policy in
3	the future by—
4	"(i) playing a significant role in devel-
5	oping the next generation of environmental
6	and Native American leaders; and
7	"(ii) working with current leaders to
8	improve decisionmaking on—
9	"(I) challenging environmental,
10	energy, and related economic prob-
11	lems; and
12	"(II) tribal governance and eco-
13	nomic issues;
14	"(6) Stewart L. Udall, as a member of Con-
15	gress, Secretary of the Interior, environmental law-
16	yer, and author, has provided distinguished national
17	leadership in environmental and Native American
18	policy for more than 50 years;
19	"(7) as Secretary of the Interior from 1961 to
20	1969, Stewart L. Udall oversaw the creation of $4$
21	national parks, 6 national monuments, 8 national
22	seashores and lakeshores, 9 recreation areas, 20 his-
23	toric sites, and 56 wildlife refuges; and
24	"(8) it is fitting that the leadership and vision
25	of Stewart L. Udall in the areas of environmental

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1	and Native American policy be jointly honored with
2	that of Morris K. Udall through the foundation
3	bearing the Udall name.".
4	SEC. 4. DEFINITIONS.
5	Section 4 of the Morris K. Udall and Stewart L.

7	(1) in paragraph (1), by striking "Morris K.

10	(2) in paragraph (5), by striking "Scholarship
11	and Excellence in National Environmental Policy"
12	and inserting "and Stewart L. Udall"; and
13	(3) in paragraph (9), by striking "Scholarship
14	and Excellence in National Environmental Policy"
15	and inserting "and Stewart L. Udall".
16	SEC. 5. ESTABLISHMENT OF FOUNDATION.
17	Section 5 of the Morris K. Udall and Stewart L.
18	Udall Foundation Act (20 U.S.C. 5603) is amended—
19	(1) in the section heading, by striking " <b>SCHOL-</b>
20	ARSHIP AND EXCELLENCE IN NATIONAL ENVI-
21	<b>RONMENTAL POLICY</b> " and inserting "AND STEW-
22	ART L. UDALL";
23	(2) in subsection (a), by striking "Scholarship
24	and Excellence in National Environmental Policy"
25	and inserting "and Stewart L. Udall"; and

1	(3) in subsection $(f)(2)$ , by striking "the rate
2	specified for employees in level IV of the Executive
3	Schedule under section 5315 of title 5, United
4	States Code" and inserting "a rate determined by
5	the Board in accordance with section 5383 of title
6	5, United States Code".
7	SEC. 6. AUTHORITY OF FOUNDATION.
8	Section 7 of the Morris K. Udall and Stewart L.
9	Udall Foundation Act (20 U.S.C. 5605) is amended—
10	(1) in subsection $(a)(5)$ —
11	(A) in subparagraph (C), by striking
12	"and" at the end;
13	(B) in subparagraph (D), by striking the
14	period at the end and inserting "; and"; and
15	(C) by adding at the end the following:
16	"(E) to conduct training, research, and
17	other activities under section $6(7)$ ."; and
18	(2) by striking subsection (b) and inserting the
19	following:
20	"(b) UDALL SCHOLARS.—Recipients of scholarships,
21	fellowships, and internships under this Act shall be known
22	as 'Udall Scholars', 'Udall Fellows', and 'Udall Interns',
23	respectively.".

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# 1 SEC. 7. ESTABLISHMENT OF TRUST FUND.

2 Section 8 of the Morris K. Udall and Stewart L.
3 Udall Foundation Act (20 U.S.C. 5606) is amended—

4 (1) in the section heading, by striking "SCHOL5 ARSHIP AND EXCELLENCE IN NATIONAL ENVI6 RONMENTAL POLICY" and inserting "AND STEW7 ART L. UDALL"; and

8 (2) in subsection (a), by striking "Scholarship
9 and Excellence in National Environmental Policy"
10 and inserting "and Stewart L. Udall".

## 11 SEC. 8. EXPENDITURES AND AUDIT OF TRUST FUND.

Section 9(a) of the Morris K. Udall and Stewart L. Udall Foundation Act (20 U.S.C. 5607(a)) is amended by inserting before the period at the end the following: ", including a reasonable amount for official reception and representation expenses, as determined by the Board, not to exceed \$5,000 for a fiscal year".

# 18 SEC. 9. USE OF INSTITUTE BY FEDERAL AGENCY OR OTHER

# 19 ENTITY.

Section 11 of the Morris K. Udall and Stewart L.
Udall Foundation Act (20 U.S.C. 5607b) is amended by
adding at the end the following:

"(f) AGENCY MANAGEMENT OR CONTROL.—Use of
the Foundation or Institute to provide independent and
impartial assessment, mediation, or other dispute or conflict resolution under this section shall not be considered

to be the establishment or use of an advisory committee
 within the meaning of the Federal Advisory Committee
 Act (5 U.S.C. App.).".

## **4** SEC. 10. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS.

5 Section 12(a) of the Morris K. Udall and Stewart L.
6 Udall Foundation Act (20 U.S.C. 5608(a)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking paragraph (1) and inserting the8 following:

9 "(1)(A) appoint such personnel as may be nec-10 essary to carry out the provisions of this Act, with-11 out regard to the provisions of title 5, United States 12 Code, governing appointments in the competitive 13 service; and

14 "(B) fix the compensation of the personnel ap-15 pointed under subparagraph (A) at a rate not to ex-16 ceed the maximum rate for employees in grade GS-17 15 of the General Schedule under section 5332 of 18 title 5, United States Code, except that up to 4 em-19 ployees (in addition to the Executive Director under 20 section 5(f)(2) may be paid at a rate determined by 21 the Board in accordance with section 5383 of that 22 title.";

23 (2) in paragraph (6), by striking "and" at the24 end;

1 (3) by redesignating paragraph (7) as para-2 graph (8); and 3 (4) by inserting after paragraph (6) the fol-4 lowing: 5 "(7) to rent office space in the District of Co-6 lumbia or its environs; and". 7 SEC. 11. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS. 8 Section 13 of the Morris K. Udall and Stewart L. Udall Foundation Act (20 U.S.C. 5609) is amended— 9 10 (1) in subsection (a), by striking "is authorized 11 to be appropriated to the Trust Fund \$40,000,000" and inserting "are authorized to be appropriated to 12 13 the Trust Fund such sums as are necessary"; and 14 (2) by striking subsection (b) and inserting the 15 following: 16 "(b) ENVIRONMENTAL DISPUTE RESOLUTION 17 FUND.—There are authorized to be appropriated to the 18 Environmental Dispute Resolution Fund established 19 under section 10(a) such sums as are necessary for the

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operating costs of the Institute.".

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
