(1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through 7 8 (3) as subparagraphs (A) through (C), respectively, 9

(2) by striking the subsection designation and 1 2 heading and all that follows through "No partial" 3 and inserting the following: "(f) PROHIBITIONS.— 4 "(1) PARTIAL PERMIT PROGRAMS.-No par-5 tial"; and 6 (3) by adding at the end the following: 7 "(2) CERTAIN EMISSIONS FROM AGRICULTURAL 8 9 PRODUCTION.—No permit shall be issued under a 10 permit program under this title for any carbon diox-11 ide, nitrogen oxide, water vapor, or methane emis-12 sions resulting from biological processes associated with livestock production.". 13
