1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans 2nd Amend-3 ment Protection Act".

4 SEC. 2. CONDITIONS FOR TREATMENT OF CERTAIN PER5 SONS AS ADJUDICATED MENTALLY INCOM6 PETENT FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 55 of title 38, United
8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol9 lowing new section:

10 "§ 5511. Conditions for treatment of certain persons
 as adjudicated mentally incompetent for
 certain purposes

"In any case arising out of the administration by the 13 Secretary of laws and benefits under this title, a person 14 who is mentally incapacitated, deemed mentally incom-15 16 petent, or experiencing an extended loss of consciousness 17 shall not be considered adjudicated as a mental defective under subsection (d)(4) or (g)(4) of section 922 of title 18 19 18 without the order or finding of a judge, magistrate, 20or other judicial authority of competent jurisdiction that 21 such person is a danger to himself or herself or others.". 22 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections 23 at the beginning of chapter 55 of such title is amended

24 by adding at the end the following new item:

"5511. Conditions for treatment of certain persons as adjudicated mentally incompetent for certain purposes.".
