- 8 propriated to carry out this Act, to remain available until

- 10 "(1) \$8,000,000 for fiscal year 2010;
- "(2) \$11,000,000 for fiscal year 2011;
- "(3) \$13,000,000 for fiscal year 2012;
- "(4) \$16,000,000 for fiscal year 2013;
- "(5) \$18,000,000 for fiscal year 2014; and
- 15 "(6) \$20,000,000 for fiscal year 2015.
