To amend the Andean Trade Preference Act to add Paraguay to the list of countries that are eligible to be designated as beneficiary countries and ATPDEA beneficiary countries.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “U.S.-Paraguay Part-
5 nership Act of 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO ANDEAN TRADE PREFERENCE**
2 **ACT.**

3 (a) ADDITION OF PARAGUAY TO LIST OF ELIGIBLE
4 COUNTRIES.—Section 203(b)(1) of the Andean Trade
5 Preference Act (19 U.S.C. 3202(b)(1)) is amended by in-
6 serting after “Colombia” the following:

7 “Paraguay”.

8 (b) TERMINATION OF DUTY-FREE TREATMENT.—
9 Section 208(a)(1) of such Act (19 U.S.C. 3206(a)(1)) is
10 amended by striking “or Peru” and inserting “, Paraguay,
11 or Peru”.

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
