Ms. SNOWE (for herself and Mr. CASEY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To require the President to update and modify the website
recovery.gov.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATIONS TO RECOVERY.GOV.**

4 In order to facilitate the timely distribution of funds
5 under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub-
6 lic Law 111–5) and to ensure that such funds are used
7 as quickly and efficiently as possible to help restore eco-
8 nomic growth, the President shall modify and update the
9 website recovery.gov to—

1 (1) ensure that States, cities, counties, towns,
2 townships, parishes, villages, or other general pur-
3 pose political subdivisions of a State can easily as-
4 certain—

5 (A) whether such entity is eligible for any
6 funds under the American Recovery and Rein-
7 vestment Act;

8 (B) any application deadlines that are ap-
9 plicable to the receipt of such funds; and

10 (C) the contact information of any office,
11 agency, program, or other entity responsible for
12 the distribution of such funds; and

13 (2) create an online database that catalogues all
14 programs and activities under the American Recov-
15 ery and Reinvestment Act.
