- 9 (a) In General.—

1	(1) Individuals.—Subparagraph (E) of sec-
2	tion 170(b)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
3	(relating to contributions of qualified conservation
4	contributions) is amended by striking clause (vi).

- (2) Corporations.—Subparagraph (B) of section 170(b)(2) of such Code (relating to qualified conservation contributions) is amended by striking clause (iii).
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by 10 this section shall apply to contributions made in taxable 11 years beginning after the date of the enactment of this 12 Act.
