Mr. VITTER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

A BILL

To amend part B of the Individuals with Disabilities
Education Act to provide full Federal funding of such part.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “IDEA Full Funding
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO IDEA.**

7 Section 611(i) of the Individuals with Disabilities
8 Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1411(i)) is amended to read
9 as follows:

1 “(i) FUNDING.—For the purpose of carrying out this
2 part, other than section 619, there are authorized to be
3 appropriated—

4 “(1) \$12,144,803,000 for fiscal year 2010, and
5 there are hereby appropriated \$1,361,842,000 for
6 fiscal year 2010, which shall become available for
7 obligation on July 1, 2010, and shall remain avail-
8 able through September 30, 2011;

9 “(2) \$13,987,521,000 for fiscal year 2011, and
10 there are hereby appropriated \$3,204,560,000 for
11 fiscal year 2011, which shall become available for
12 obligation on July 1, 2011, and shall remain avail-
13 able through September 30, 2012;

14 “(3) \$15,957,362,000 for fiscal year 2012, and
15 there are hereby appropriated \$5,174,401,000 for
16 fiscal year 2012, which shall become available for
17 obligation on July 1, 2012, and shall remain avail-
18 able through September 30, 2013;

19 “(4) \$18,292,338,000 for fiscal year 2013, and
20 there are hereby appropriated \$7,509,377,000 for
21 fiscal year 2013, which shall become available for
22 obligation on July 1, 2013, and shall remain avail-
23 able through September 30, 2014;

24 “(5) \$20,848,085,000 for fiscal year 2014, and
25 there are hereby appropriated \$10,065,124,000 for

1 fiscal year 2014, which shall become available for
2 obligation on July 1, 2014, and shall remain avail-
3 able through September 30, 2015;

4 “(6) \$23,772,812,000 for fiscal year 2015, and
5 there are hereby appropriated \$12,989,851,000 for
6 fiscal year 2015, which shall become available for
7 obligation on July 1, 2015, and shall remain avail-
8 able through September 30, 2016;

9 “(7) \$27,075,420,000 for fiscal year 2016, and
10 there are hereby appropriated \$16,292,459,000 for
11 fiscal year 2016, which shall become available for
12 obligation on July 1, 2016, and shall remain avail-
13 able through September 30, 2017;

14 “(8) \$30,837,945,000 for fiscal year 2017, and
15 there are hereby appropriated \$20,054,984,000 for
16 fiscal year 2017, which shall become available for
17 obligation on July 1, 2017, and shall remain avail-
18 able through September 30, 2018; and

19 “(9) an amount equal to the sum of the max-
20 imum amounts of the grants all States may receive
21 under subsection (a)(2)(B) for fiscal year 2018 and
22 each succeeding fiscal year, and, there are hereby
23 appropriated for each such year an amount equal to
24 the sum of the maximum amounts of the grants all
25 States may receive under subsection (a)(2)(B) for

1 the fiscal year for which the determination is made
2 minus \$10,782,961,000, which shall become avail-
3 able for obligation on July 1 of the fiscal year for
4 which the determination is made and shall remain
5 available through September 30 of the succeeding
6 year.”.

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
