3 SEC. 2. AGREEMENTS FOR HOUSING AND OTHER SERVICES.

- 4 (a) In General.—The Board of Regents of the
- 5 Smithsonian Institution is authorized to enter into agree-
- 6 ments for the provision of housing and other services to
- 7 the participants in the programs described in section 1.
- 8 (b) Costs.—The housing and other services de-
- 9 scribed in subsection (a) shall be provided at no cost to
- 10 the Smithsonian Institution.

11 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

- There is authorized to be appropriated to carry out
- 13 section 1—
- 14 (1) \$1,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2010
- and 2011; and
- 16 (2) \$3,000,000 in the aggregate for all suc-
- 17 ceeding fiscal years.
