- Whereas gospel music is a testament to the universal appeal of a historical art form of the United States that both

inspires and entertains across racial, ethnic, religious, and geographical boundaries: Now, therefore, be it

- 4 (2) recognizes the valuable contributions to the
- 5 culture of the United States derived from the rich
- 6 heritage of gospel music and gospel music artists.
