monetary donations of clothing, toys, food, and
housewares for charitable purposes related to serving
those in need or members of the Armed Services and
their families during the holiday season, if the charitable purposes do not otherwise violate any rule or
regulation of the Senate or of Federal law; and

7 (2) a Senator, officer, or employee of the Sen8 ate may work with a nonprofit organization with re9 spect to the delivery of donations described in para10 graph (1).

(b) EXPIRATION.—The authority provided by this
resolution shall expire at the end of the 2nd session of
the 111th Congress.
