CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate 2 *concurring*), That it is the sense of Congress that the 3 President should adhere to the War Powers Resolution 4 and obtain specific statutory authorization for the use of 5 United States Armed Forces in Libya within 60 days of 6 initiating military action in Libya, of which the President notified Congress of initial action on March 19, 2011, or 7 terminate the use of United States Armed Forces in Libya 8
