JOINT RESOLUTION

Removing the deadline for the ratification of the equal rights amendment.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That notwithstanding any time limit contained in House
4 Joint Resolution 208 of the Ninety-second Congress, sec-
5 ond session, the article of amendment proposed to the
6 States in that joint resolution shall be valid to all intents
7 and purposes as part of the Constitution whenever ratified
8 by three additional States.
