## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to require a two-thirds vote of each House of Congress to increase the statutory limit on the public debt.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several

- 1 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 2 for ratification:
- 3 "Article—
- 4 "Section 1. Congress shall, by law, establish a stat-
- 5 utory limit on the public debt. If such a limit is in effect
- 6 upon the date of adoption of this article, that limit shall
- 7 be the limit for purposes of this section.
- 8 "Section 2. The statutory limit on the public debt
- 9 may only be increased by the passage of legislation upon
- 10 the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Members of each
- 11 House, a quorum being present.".
