A BILL

- To amend title 10, United States Code, to authorize spaceavailable travel on military aircraft for reserve members, former members of a reserve component, and unremarried surviving spouses and dependents of such members and former members.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

1	SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF RESERVE MEMBERS, FORMER
2	RESERVE MEMBERS, AND THEIR SURVIVING
3	SPOUSES AND DEPENDENTS FOR SPACE-
4	AVAILABLE TRAVEL ON MILITARY AIRCRAFT.
5	(a) Eligibility.—Chapter 157 of title 10, United
6	States Code, is amended by inserting after section 2641b
7	the following new section:
8	"§ 2641c. Space-available travel on Department of De-
9	fense aircraft: reserve members; former
10	reserve members; surviving spouses; de-
11	pendents.
12	"(a) Members and Former Members of Reserve
13	Components.—
14	"(1) Reserve members.—A member of a re-
15	serve component holding a valid Uniformed Services
16	Identification and Privilege Card shall be provided
17	transportation on Department of Defense aircraft,
18	on a space-available basis, on the same basis as ac-
19	tive duty members of the armed forces.
20	"(2) Reserve retirees eligible for re-
21	TIRED PAY.—A former member of a reserve compo-
22	nent entitled to retired pay under chapter 1223 of
23	this title shall be provided transportation on Depart-
24	ment of Defense aircraft, on a space-available basis,
25	on the same basis as members of the armed forces
26	entitled to retired pay.

1 "(3) Reserve retirees under applicable 2 ELIGIBILITY AGE.—A former member of a reserve 3 component who, but for being under the eligibility age applicable to the member under section 12731 of this title, would be eligible for retired pay under 5 6 chapter 1223 of this title, shall be provided trans-7 portation on Department of Defense aircraft, on a 8 space-available basis, on the same basis as members 9 of the armed forces entitled to retired pay.

"(b) Unremarried Surviving Spouses.—The unremarried surviving spouse of a member or former member described in subsection (a) shall be provided transportation on Department of Defense aircraft, on a space-available basis, on the same basis as a spouse of a retired member of the armed forces.

"(c) Dependents.—

"(1) DEPENDENTS OF MEMBERS OR FORMER MEMBERS.—The dependent of a member or former member described in subsection (a) shall be provided transportation on Department of Defense aircraft, on a space-available basis, if the dependent is accompanying the member or former member.

"(2) DEPENDENTS OF UNREMARRIED SUR-VIVING SPOUSES.—The dependent of a surviving spouse described in subsection (b) shall be provided

- 1 transportation on Department of Defense aircraft,
- 2 on a space-available basis, if the dependent is accom-
- 3 panying the surviving spouse.".
- 4 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
- 5 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting
- 6 after the item relating to section 2641b the following new
- 7 item:

"2641c. Space-available travel on Department of Defense aircraft: reserve members; former reserve members; surviving spouses; dependents.".
