1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Energy Employees Oc3 cupational Illness Compensation Program Improvement
4 Act of 2011".

5 SEC. 2. PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION TO SURVIVORS OF
6 DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY CONTRACTOR EM7 PLOYEES.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3672 of the Energy Em-9 ployees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act 10 of 2000 (42 U.S.C. 7385s–1) is amended to read as fol-11 lows:

12 "SEC. 3672. COMPENSATION TO BE PROVIDED.

13 "Subject to the other provisions of this subtitle:

14 "(1) CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEES.—

"(A) IN GENERAL.—A covered DOE contractor employee shall receive contractor employee compensation under this subtitle in accordance with section 3673.

19"(B) COMPENSATION AFTER DEATH OF20CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEE.—

21 "(i) IN GENERAL.—Except as pro22 vided in paragraph (2)(B), if the death of
23 a contractor employee occurs after the em24 ployee applies for compensation under this
25 subtitle but before such compensation is
26 paid, the amount of compensation de-

1	scribed in clause (ii) shall be paid to a sur-
2	vivor (as that term is used in section
3	3674) of the employee or, if the employee
4	has no such survivors, to the surviving
5	family members of the employee in accord-
6	ance with the procedures set forth in sec-
7	tion $3628(e)(1)$.
8	"(ii) Amount of compensation
9	The amount of compensation described in
10	this clause is the amount of compensation
11	the contractor employee would have re-
12	ceived pursuant to section 3673(a), except
13	that if the Secretary cannot determine the
14	minimum impairment rating of the em-
15	ployee under paragraph (1) of such section
16	as a result of the death of the employee,
17	such compensation shall not include com-
18	pensation pursuant to such paragraph.
19	"(2) SURVIVORS.—
20	"(A) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in
21	subparagraph (B) or paragraph (1)(B), a sur-
22	vivor of a covered DOE contractor employee
23	shall receive contractor employee compensation
24	under this subtitle in accordance with section
25	3674.

1 "(B) ELECTION OF CONTRACTOR EM-2 PLOYEE COMPENSATION OR SURVIVOR COM-PENSATION.—A survivor who is otherwise eligi-3 4 ble to receive compensation pursuant to both 5 subparagraph (A) and paragraph (1)(B) shall 6 not receive compensation pursuant to both sub-7 paragraph (A) and paragraph (1)(B), but shall 8 receive compensation pursuant to subparagraph 9 (A) or paragraph (1)(B), as elected by the sur-10 vivor.

11 "(C) COMPENSATION AFTER DEATH OF 12 SURVIVOR.—If the death of a survivor occurs 13 after the survivor applies for compensation 14 under this subtitle but before such compensa-15 tion is paid and, in the case of compensation 16 pursuant to paragraph (1)(B), there are no 17 other survivors (as that term is used in section 18 3674) of the employee, the amount of com-19 pensation the survivor would have received 20 under this section shall be paid to the surviving 21 family members of the employee in accordance 22 with the procedures set forth in section 23 3628(e)(1).".

24 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The provisions of section 3672
25 of the Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensa-

tion Program Act of 2000 (42 U.S.C. 7385s-1), as
 amended by subsection (a), shall apply to applications for
 compensation under subtitle E of such Act filed before,
 on, or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
