## A BILL

To require Federal agencies to show receipts and expenditures every two weeks on agency websites.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Agency Trans-
- 5 parency Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR FEDERAL AGENCIES TO SHOW
- 7 RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES ON
- 8 WEBSITES.
- 9 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Each Federal agency shall pub-
- 10 lish on the official public website of the agency, at the

- 1 end of each two-week period, a statement of all funds re-
- 2 ceived and spent by the agency during that two-week pe-
- 3 riod.
- 4 (b) FEDERAL AGENCY DEFINED.—In this Act, the
- 5 term "Federal agency" has the meaning given the term
- 6 "executive agency" in section 133 of title 41, United
- 7 States Code.
- 8 (c) Implementation.—The requirement of this sec-
- 9 tion shall be implemented beginning not later than 30
- 10 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
