REPEALING MANDATORY FUNDING FOR 2 SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER CONSTRUC-3 TION. 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (a) of section 4101 of 5 the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42) U.S.C. 280h–4) is repealed. 6 7 (b) RESCISSION OF UNOBLIGATED FUNDS.—Of the 8 funds made available by section 4101(a) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 280h-9 4(a)), the unobligated balance is rescinded. 10
