A BILL

To amend the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act to suspend a limitation on the period for which certain borrowers are eligible for guaranteed assistance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF LIMITATION ON PERIOD FOR

WHICH BORROWERS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR

GUARANTEED ASSISTANCE.

Section 319(b) of the Consolidated Farm and Rural

Development Act (7 U.S.C. 1949(b)) is amended—

(1) in paragraph (1), by striking "paragraph

(2)" and inserting "paragraphs (2) and (3)"; and

1	(2) by adding at the end the following:
2	"(3) Suspension.—During the period begin-
3	ning December 31, 2010, and ending December 31,
4	2011, paragraph (1) shall have no force or effect.".
