- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Energy Production
- 5 Freedom Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. GREENHOUSE GAS REGULATION UNDER CLEAN AIR
- 7 **ACT.**
- 8 Section 302(g) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
- 9 7602(g)) is amended by adding the following at the end
- 10 thereof: "The term 'air pollutant' shall not include carbon

- 1 dioxide, methane, nitrous oxide, hydrofluorocarbons,
- 2 perfluorocarbons, or sulfur hexafluoride.".
- 3 SEC. 3. CLIMATE CHANGE NOT REGULATED BY CLEAN AIR
- 4 **ACT.**
- Nothing in the Clean Air Act shall be treated as au-
- 6 thorizing or requiring the regulation of climate change or
- 7 global warming.
